

Instructions

- 1) Students from autonomous colleges affiliated to Sardar Patel University, who are interested in obtaining admission to the 4th (semester 7) of 4 Year UG programmes (Honours / Research), are required to fill the attached form (Option Form) and submit it to the Academic Section of Sardar Patel University, along with the true copies of the marksheet (Seme) attested by the principal of the respective college.
- 2) This form is valid only for students of the autonomous colleges affiliated to Sardar Patel University.
- 3) College selection and admission workflow

To ensure a fair, transparent, and centralized allocation of students to the fourth-year undergraduate programmes, the admission process shall be administered exclusively by SPU as follows:

- i) University Department/College Selection: Students shall select a pool of University departments/colleges where they wish to pursue the fourth year of the undergraduate programme. Students shall indicate their choice of eligible colleges/departments in the order of their preference.
 - ii) Fourth-Year Honours with Research track: This track shall, for the current academic year, will be offered exclusively through the University Departments. Students opting for this pathway shall be eligible for admission only to the designated University Departments offering the programme, subject to the prescribed eligibility criteria.
 - iii) This academic year Colleges (other than university departments) will offer only the Honours track.
 - iv) The University shall process the submitted University department/college choices and generate college-wise merit lists based on the CGPA obtained by students at the end of the 6th semester, in accordance with the applicable eligibility criteria and preference of college.
 - v) The generated merit lists shall be made available directly through the university administrative dashboards for further admission processing.
 - vi) Admission Rounds:
 - a) The University shall publish a centralized admission schedule and upload the approved seat matrix, including applicable reservation quotas, into the ERP system.
 - b) Departments/Colleges shall conduct admission rounds in accordance with the notified schedule and shall allot seats strictly on the basis of the merit lists and prevailing reservation policies.
- 4) Admission Finalization: Upon completion of the admission rounds, the University shall lock the admission portal. The details of admitted students shall thereafter be reflected on the respective college/department dashboards, and the allotted college/department information shall simultaneously be updated on the students' dashboards for commencement of the 7th semester.
- 5) **Important note to students opting to continue to 4th Year of BCA and BBA**
- i) Students seeking admission to the 4th Year of BCA and BBA programmes are requested to note that the All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE) has not yet released the regulations governing the proposed one-year MCA and MBA programmes.
 - ii) Therefore, MCA and MBA programmes shall continue to be offered as two-year postgraduate programmes. Any change in the duration of these programmes will be subject to the notification and implementation of the relevant AICTE regulations.
