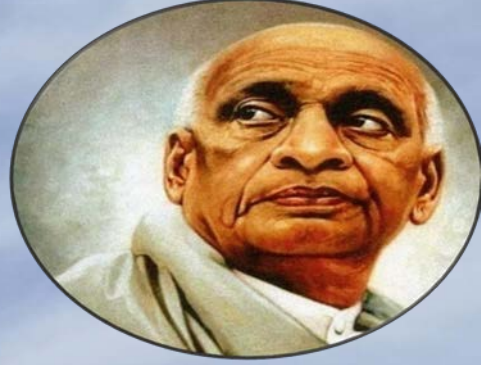




# Post Graduate Department of Psychology Sardar Patel University Vallabh Vidyanagar – Gujarat

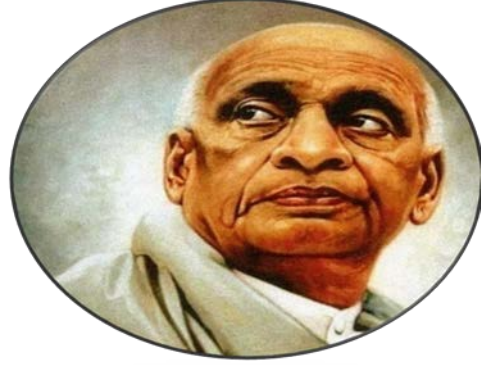
