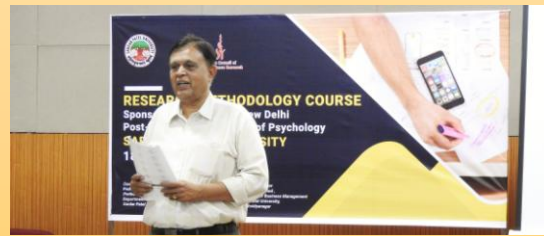
15. Meaning of Primary and secondary data with quantities and qualitative data collection and evaluation with used of library by Prof.H.P.Trivedi:
