	<p><b>Paintings and graphics.</b>            Prepare a variety of brushes from different types of brooms, cotton, wool, strips of cloth, feather etc. where necessary demonstration of preparation of materials required for conducting activity be included, i.e. paste, paint with starch, dry colors etc.            Drawing with crayons, dry and wet chalk.            Wet paints, painting masks, brush music.</p>	
	<p><b>Tearing, cutting, pasting.</b>            Tearing with all finger, tearing with thumb, and two fingers as used in holding pencil, tearing on straight line, curved line.            Tearing circular rings starting from one corner of the page till center of page, making designs.            Cutting a design, pasting, pieces of paper, cloth, stick, leaf, collage, and mosaic.            Tracing and cutting designs, creating design.            Pasting mosaic, paper balls, and glass pieces. Etc.</p>	
	<p><b>Modeling</b>            Modeling with clay, dough, plastacine, saw dust, providing accessories.            Beside above medium, modeling with straw, match sticks rope, wire, thick paper fold and slot sculpture.            Pasting papers on a balloon, when dry remove air and colors to create accessories for clay sculpture/ crumbled paper pasting designs.</p>	
	<p><b>Printing</b>            Printing with strings, leaf, vegetable blocks, stencil printing, thumb, finger, spray printing.            Keepings coins, leaves with veins below paper and gently coloring with crayon.            Older children to make their own stencil.</p>	
	<p><b>Decorating empty plastic bottles, boxes, mask etc.</b>  <b>Music and movement</b>            Making simple musical instruments.            Rhythmic body movement according to different beats and sound.            Dancing according to the rhythm.            Musical instruments from waste like old pots, tins, sticks.</p>
