To Apply knowledge from physical, biological and behavioral sciences, medicine including alternative systems and nursing in providing care to individuals, families and communities.</li><li>2. To provide nursing care based on steps of nursing process in collaboration with the individuals and groups.</li><li>3. To Demonstrate critical thinking skill in making decisions in all situations in order to provide quality care.</li><li>4. To utilize the latest trends and technology in providing health care.</li><li>5. To Practice within the frame work of code of ethics and professional conduct, and acceptable standards of practice within the legal boundaries.</li><li>6. To assess the health status, identify and prioritize the nursing needs, plan, implement and evaluate care of the patients in the hospital and community.</li><li>1. To communicate effectively with individuals and groups and members of the health team in order to promote effective interpersonal relationships and teamwork.</li></ol>
<b>To Pass:</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. A candidate must have minimum of 80% attendance (irrespective of the kind of absence) in theory and practical in each course/subject for appearing for examination.</li><li>2. Minimum pass marks shall be 50% in each of the Theory and practical papers Internal and External examination separately except in English.</li><li>3. The student has to pass in all mandatory modules placed within courses and the pass mark for each module is 50% (C Grade).</li><li>4. Candidate must complete 1 elective module either in III or IV semester, marks are not included for calculating SGPA</li><li>5. <b>*Professionalism, Professional, values and ethics including bioethics (UM04CPPE04)</b> College Exam, marks are not added for calculating SGPA, Pass mark-40%</li><li>6. Minimum pass mark shall be 40% for each of the Elective module. All Electives modules must be completed as indicated in specified semester and pass marks sent to university before appearing for final examination</li><li>7. If a candidate fails in either theory or practical, he/she has to re-appear for both the papers (Theory and Practical).</li><li>8. Assessment guidelines based on grading of performance. Each student shall be awarded a final grade at the end of the semester for each course. Absolute grading is used by converting the marks to grade, based on predetermined class interval.</li><li>9. UGC 10 point grading system is used with pass grade modified.</li><li>10. A Candidate must have 100% attendance in each of the practical areas before award of degree.</li><li>11. <b>If the student has failed in only one subject and has passed in all the other subjects of a particular semester and Grace marks of up to 5 marks to theory marks can be added for one course/subject only, provided that by such an addition the student passes the semester examination.</b></li></ol>
