## Q.4 (B) Read the following passage carefully and answer the questions given below. 10

The famous painter Nandlal Bose once wrote literature, art, music and dance provide us with inner delight which we experience with our mind and senses. The education in arts is important because it raises our knowledge and inner delight. We cannot acquire this experience through reading and writing. Written words on different forms of arts and literature can merely give us some information but not the realisation that we experience from within. To ensure total development of the young minds, art training should be given equal importance to science and humanities. But,unfortunately, our univerties do not often consider this as important. As a result, in most of cases, they do not always create adequate provision for art training. It is wrongly believed that art is the exclusive monopoly of few professionals. This perception is so strong even among the educated mass that they consider art and literature does not have much importance in our cognitive development. These are just for our recreation and we can do away with these if we want to. Some of us think that only the rich and the pleasure-loving can value a work of art. People who struggle to survive and work hard, they cannot afford to spend their time in such activities. These people often forget the fact that the greatest literature and art forms of the world have their roots in different folk art. Psychologists and pedagogists have also conducted long research to show that art and literature has a strong role in the cognitive development of a child.
