- b. Read the following passage and answer the questions in brief: 10

Amul is an Indian cooperative dairy company, based at Anand in the state of Gujarat. Formed in 1956, it is a cooperative brand managed by a cooperative body, the Gujarat Co-operative Milk Marketing Federation Ltd. (GCMMF), which today is jointly owned by 3.6 million milk producers in Gujarat. Amul spurred India's White Revolution, which made the country the world's largest producer of milk and milk products. Amul was spearheaded by Tribhuvandas Patel under the guidance of Sardar Patel to stop the exploitation of milk producers by middlemen. As a result, Kaira District Co-operative Milk Producers Union Limited was born in 1946 which is now known as the Amul dairy. Tribhuvandas became the founding chairman of the organization and led it until his death. He hired Dr. Verghese Kurien in 1949. Kurien, founder-chairman of the GCMMF for more than 30 years (1973–2006), is credited with the success of Amul's marketing. It is the apex organisation of the dairy cooperatives of Gujarat. Today Amul's products include milk, ghee, cheese, butter, ice-cream etc. On September 30, 2018, Prime Minister Narendra Modi inaugurated Amul's chocolate plant in Mogar, Anand near their headquarters.
