Is Municipal Corporation which is having the control of that building liable to pay compensation for the consequences of the collapse of the structure? Justify this with proper case law.
- 2. The owner urged a few boys to push the truck chassis, which was without any engine, and one of the boys fell down and was run over by the said vehicle as a consequence of which he died. In an action by the parents of the deceased boy to claim compensation. Are the parents of the deceased boy eligible to claim the compensation under the Motor Vehicle Act? Justify this with appropriate case laws.
- 3. Here the complainant purchased a computer for his personal use, which was to be used by his office staff for the purpose of business. The complainant was a contractor by profession. The computer was not being used to earn his livelihood. The computer did not work properly from the very beginning. Is the complainant eligible to file a case in consumer forum?
