Reliance Industries (RIL) has bought one of the largest Petrochemical Policies in the world with an insurance cover in excess of 3 lac crore for its refinery and petrochemical plants located at Jamnagar & Hazira in Gujarat. The cover has been provided by New India Assurance & other co- insurers with support from GIC Re which bears the bulk of the risk in this cover.

The 3 lac crore policy is more than 33% higher than the last year's cover for over 2 lac crore. The rise in the sum insured follows the increase in refining capacity to 1.24 barrels of oil per day. On Tuesday RIL said that it has successfully commissioned & achieved design throughput of the world's first ever & largest Refinery Off Gas Cracker (ROGC) complex of 1.5 MMTPA capacities.

RIL has historically been the largest insurance cover in the country. The largest capital expenditure by RIL is a reflection of RIL's strategy for vertical integration.
