Expert says that waterborne disease like cholera, jaundice and typhoid and vector-borne diseases like malaria and dengue are controllable with a little effort. Dr. Vijay Kohli of the Ahmedabad Municipal Corporation says "Controlling monsoon diseases must be a collective effort at the citizen and government level.
