

Action taken report on feedback provided by the students

2016-17

It is observed from the feedback of the students that all the courses were found appropriate and relevant to the societal requirements. They have given overall 'very good' and 'good' ratings to all the courses offered by the Department at master's level.

The overall picture that has emerged from the feedback given by the students with respect to the administrative facilities and functioning is found satisfactory. Most of the students replied that they are satisfied with the prospectus and information provided during the admission process. They are also found to be satisfied with the infrastructural facilities and administrative affairs. All the students have also given favourable feedback regarding library facilities, books and reading materials and for computer laboratory, availability of adequate number of computers. Students have shown a very high confidence in the teaching faculties and their teaching ability. They have also shown their satisfaction with the continuous evaluation as well as examination system. In this context there is no need for any action to be taken.

However, it was suggested by the students that the existing program did not have a provision for opting a course in other departments. Since the university regulations do not have such provisions, this suggestion could not be implemented. However, later in university meetings the said suggestion was communicated informally.


Further, students observed lack of sufficient relevant reading material. Considering this suggestion more provisions and purchases for vernacular (Gujarati) language reading material was done in the form of books by Gujarati authors and publishers.

Action taken report on feedback provided by the students 2017-18

All the students found the information given in the prospectus appropriate and adequate. They were found to be satisfied with all the core courses as well as elective courses offered by the Department at Master's level.

The students found administrative facilities and functioning as satisfactory. The practical component covered in the course of research methodology and computer applications in the Economics was found to have been sequenced integrally with theory classes. All the students noted that computer laboratory in the department is adequately equipped with computers, LAN, power back up system, etc. The Departmental library and the Central library of the University were also found rich with books and journals for reference and reading. The student revealed that they were provided training in the use of library facilities also. Students have shown a very high level of satisfaction with the teaching and learning support provided by all the faculty member of the department. They showed their satisfaction with the continuous evaluation as well as examination system.

But the students categorically suggested that the availability of additional learning resources was less. The students were taught to do Gujarati translation of the resources available online. With this solution and Google translation facility, most of the virtual resources were available in vernacular language although, not literal translation. Students could use such translated content with language refinement as additional resource for contemporary topics, over and above the books and journals available in the libraries.

Further, the students suggested that more placement related activities should be organized in the campus. Most of the students join Bachelor of Education (B.Ed.) course after MA (Economics), besides PhD or preparations for various government jobs or civil services exams. As an when the requirement of faculty in colleges nearby our campus arises, the college authorities contact the Department and the Department in-turn recommends students for this position informally. However, the students being freshers, are mostly hired on contract basis or informally. Its only after a few months experience / clearing NET or GSET / doing PhD, that they are hired further.

To groom students for interviews as a part of formal evaluation, viva-voce of each and every individual student is conducted. This gives them an experience of real-life interview and necessary skills to face such interview and overcome their phobia.

Action taken report on feedback provided by the students

2018-19

According to the students, the prospectus and information provided at the time of admission was found to be appropriate in addressing all their queries. They gave good ratings to all the courses offered by the Department at Master's level. Students also noted that the university was providing the facility for selecting the inter-disciplinary courses in the Master's programme offered by the Department.

But the students suggested to include the courses related to life enrichment, communication skills and ICT skills. Two faculty members were facilitated to attend the ICT course to update and upgrade their teaching skills in ICT course. A faculty from department of English was invited to teach the course on communication skills to our students. An expert from Shri Aurobindo chair of integral studies was invited to teach the course in life enrichment. The students reported that they were greatly benefitted from the above-mentioned courses.

The students gave good feedback about the administrative services. They were also found to be satisfied with the infrastructural facilities available in the department. All the students have also given favourable feedback regarding reference material available in the Departmental and Central library and the training provided for using the same.

The students gave feedback that the program did not provide an opportunity for project work. To facilitate project work for students, certain subjects, assignments based on hands on experiences were given for project work. For instance, Agricultural economics, Environmental economics, Research methodology, live stock research.

Students suggested to diversify internal weightage of Assessment. Formal continuous assessment incorporates, class participation, assignment, seminars, viva-voce, internal exams, class test, participation in co-curricular as well as extra-curricular activities (debates, mock budgets presentation). Given the time constraint bound by the term schedule these methods of internal assessment were found to be sufficient.

Action taken report on feedback provided by the students 2019-20

The students gave favourable feedback about details given in the prospectus, admission process, number and content of courses offered by the Department at Master's level.

They were also happy with the administrative facilities and infrastructure of library and computer laboratory. Students expressed that they were privileged to be studying under the learned and enthusiastic and supportive teaching faculties of the department and rated their teaching abilities very highly. The system of continuous evaluation as well as examination system was found to be very effective by the students.

It was suggested by the students that certain administrative constraint should be resolved. Due to COVID 19 and subsequent lockdown, the academic year 2019-20 got extended beyond March, due to which a lot of uncertainties related to examination and admissions were experienced. Since, a lot of related processes got converted into online mode students experienced difficulties. Lots of sessions by faculty were conducted to acquaint them with online administrative procedures, like filling online forms was facilitated in Gujarati. They were also trained to use virtual platforms like Google forms, Google docs, Google meet. However, infrastructural constraints related to lack of internet in remote villages and distant places, could not be overcome. For such students, Department also offered to use the Departmental infrastructure of Computer laboratory. It was observed that students also learned through peer-learning among themselves.

Action taken report on feedback provided by the students

2020-21

During this year, Covid-19 influenced all academic as well as extra-curricular activities for the whole year. Hence, the students were not able to attend the classes in physical mode. It is observed from the feedback given by the students that they were unable to access reading and reference material from the library which was a major issue faced by them. In this context, all the faculty members were directed to take online classes and also provided relevant reading and study material for their convenience. Faculty members were advised to counsel and motivate the students for their studies and also face the uncertain situation in a productive manner. They were also provided information about SOPs recommended by the government to be followed during the pandemic.

The department took initiatives to create awareness about covid-19 and ways and means to combat the same. More than 11000 students from all over Gujarat participated in the Online Quiz about Covid -19 and showed their interest in such activities. During this exceptional year, the method of internal as well as external assessment as well as structure of the question papers was redefined at the University level, in order to make it suitable to the pandemic situation. Students adapted well to the new format and expressed their satisfaction with the new system. However, language barrier (with only acquaintance with vernacular Gujrati language) and lack of infrastructural facilities, did act as a hindrance.

Considering the suggestion to further incorporate value-based learning outcome, additional subjects were proposed to be incorporated in the next academic year like, Economics of Gender, and Economics of Education. Besides, various topics covered in the existing syllabus deals with human values like, environmental conservation, sustainable consumption, vulnerability and human development goals and world happiness index, cooperative federalism, sustainable agriculture, and professional ethics in research.

Existing students further suggested that alumni interaction was insufficient. A special whatsapp group was created to connect with the alumni. Alumni were being informed about various events in the institute in which they can participate. NET/SLET coaching was also offered to the alumni along with existing students free of cost. Alumni enthusiastically participate now in existing Departmental events and motivate students in the campus by sharing their experiences.
