Action Taken Report on Feedback of the Students - 2016 -17

It is observed from the feedback given by the students that all the courses found appropriate and relevant to the societal requirements. They have given over all very good and good ratings to all the courses offered by the Department at Master level.

The overall picture coming out from the feedback given by the students with respect to the administrative facilities and functioning is found satisfactory. Most of the students replied that they are satisfied with the prospectus and information provided during the admission process. They are also found satisfy with the infrastructural facilities and administrative affairs. All the students have also givenfavourable feedback regarding library facilities, books and reading materials and for computer laboratory, availability of adequate numbers of computers. Students have shown a very high confidence in the teaching faculties and their teaching ability. They have also shown their satisfaction with the continuous evaluation as well as examination system.In this context there is no need for any action to be taken.

Action Taken Report on Feedback of the Students - 2017 -18

Students found the information given in the prospectus appropriate and adequate. They were also satisfied with the core courses and elective courses offered.

Students found the administrative facilities and functioning reasonable. There is no departmental library but the students' library has necessary textbooks required for the courses and some more reference books. The Bhaikaka library has more books and journals for reference and reading. The central library staff provides orientation for the use of library facilities. Students are in general happy with teaching and learning support provided by the Department. They are also satisfied evaluation and examination system. In short, viewing the feedback of the students, there was no need felt for any action to be taken.

For internal evaluation, the students were required to submit assignments in pdf to the department and which were evaluated by the staff. Given the difficult situation, the department was lenient in evaluation. The students adjusted to the new system and have had no major problems with the system in general.
