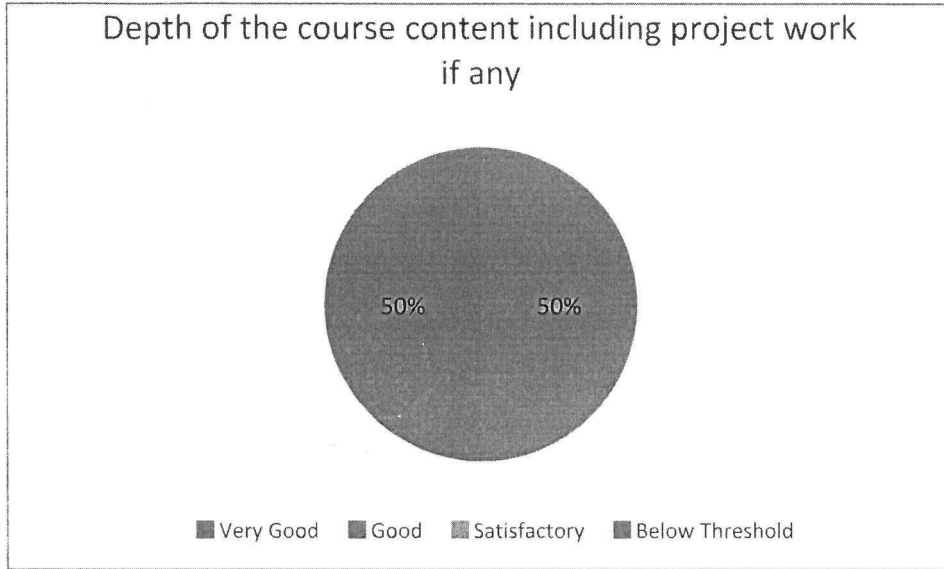

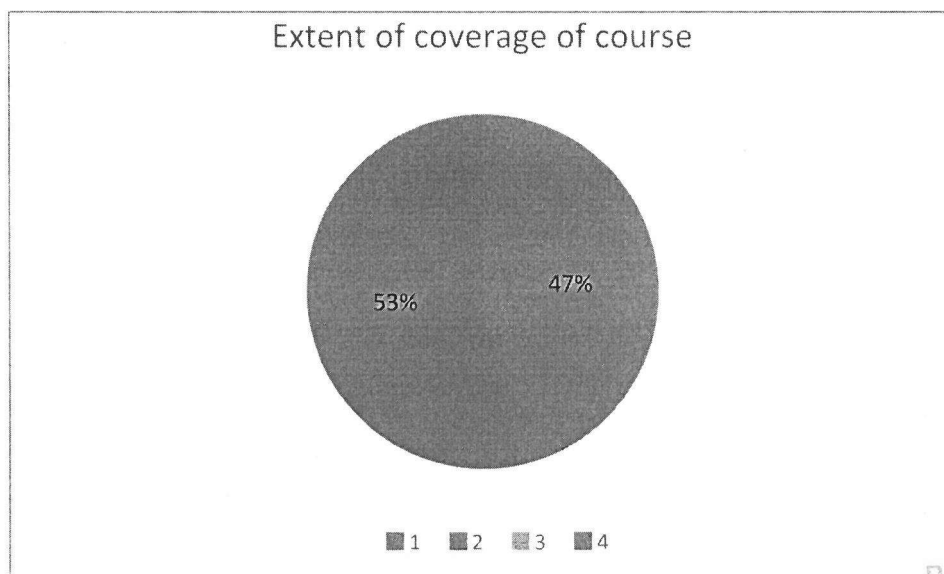
Q1	Depth of the course content including project work if any

50% students are very much satisfied with the course content. 50% students are of opinion that syllabus is worth. So the content of the LL.M. (Business Law) is proper according to them.

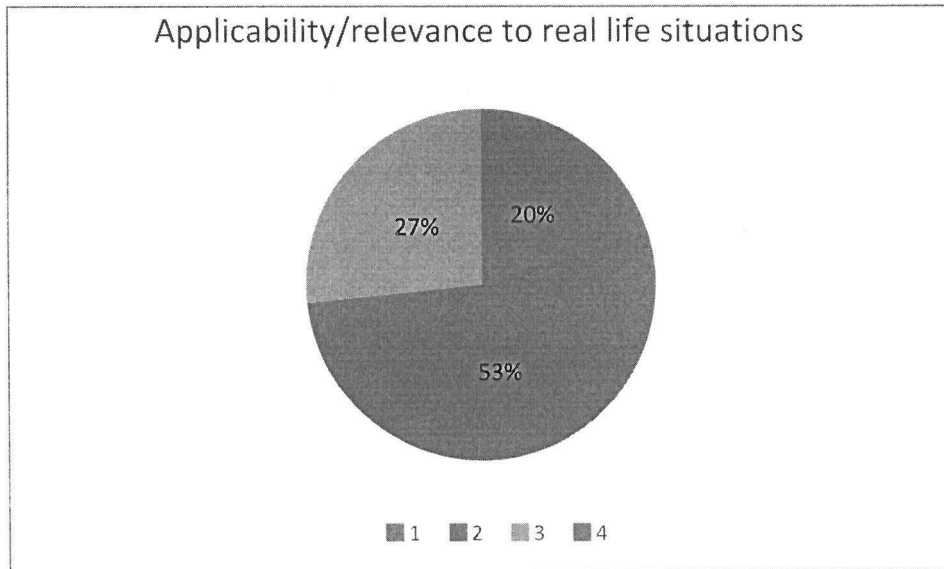
Q2	Extent of coverage of course

Q3	Applicability/relevance to real life situations
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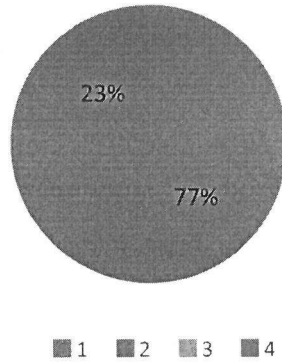

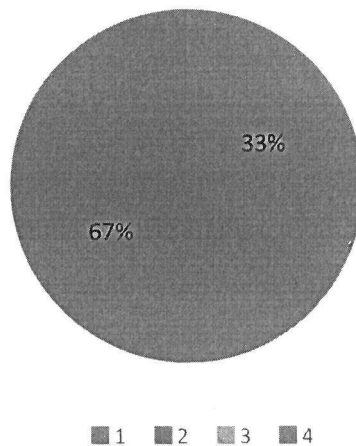

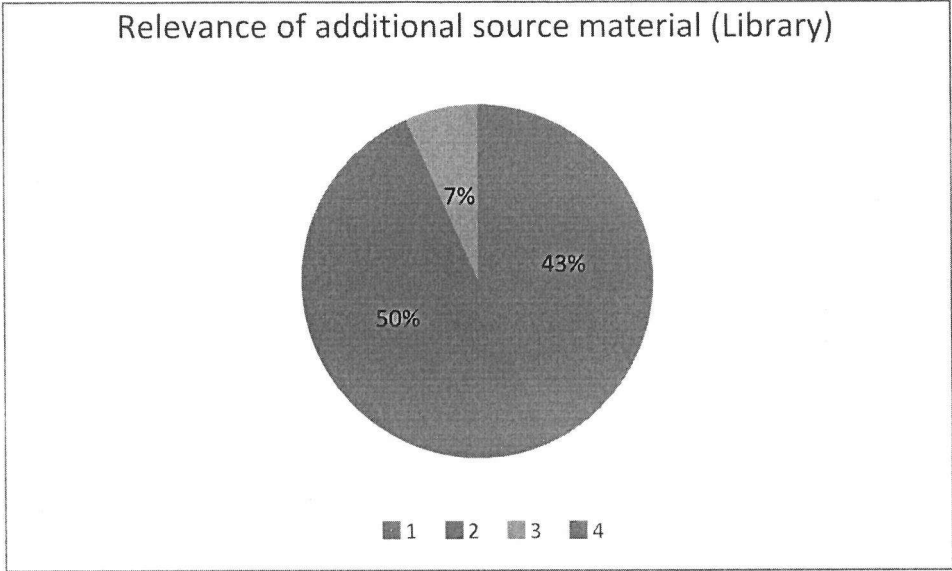

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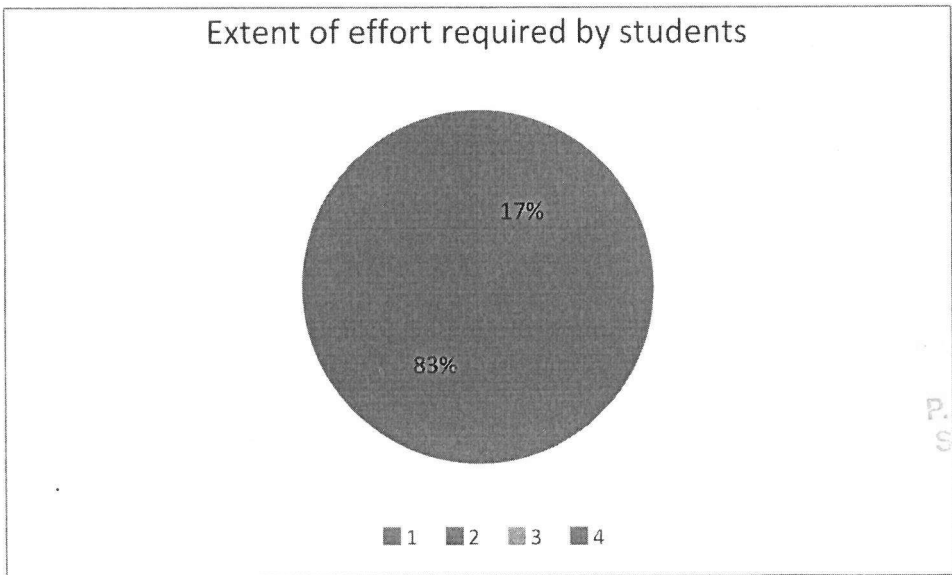

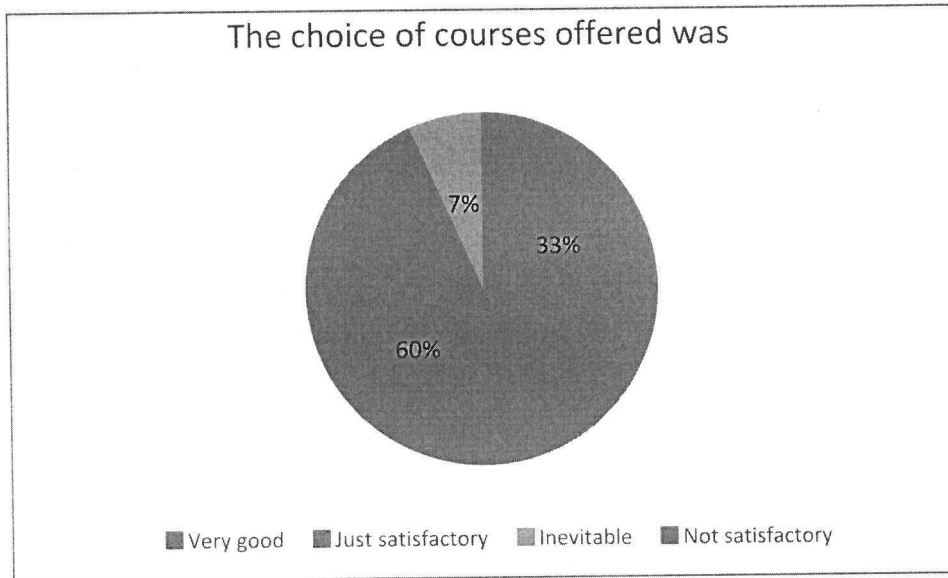
Q7	Extent of effort required by students

Q8 The choice of courses offered was

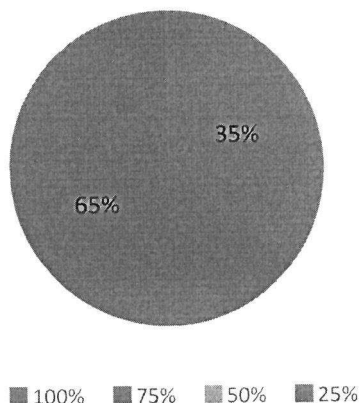

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What do you think should be the ratio of optional courses to the total number of general courses?

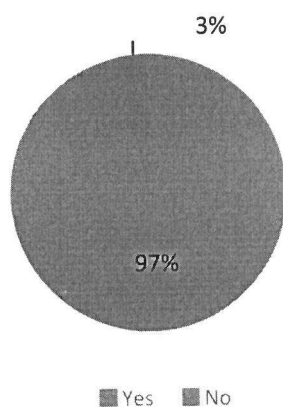

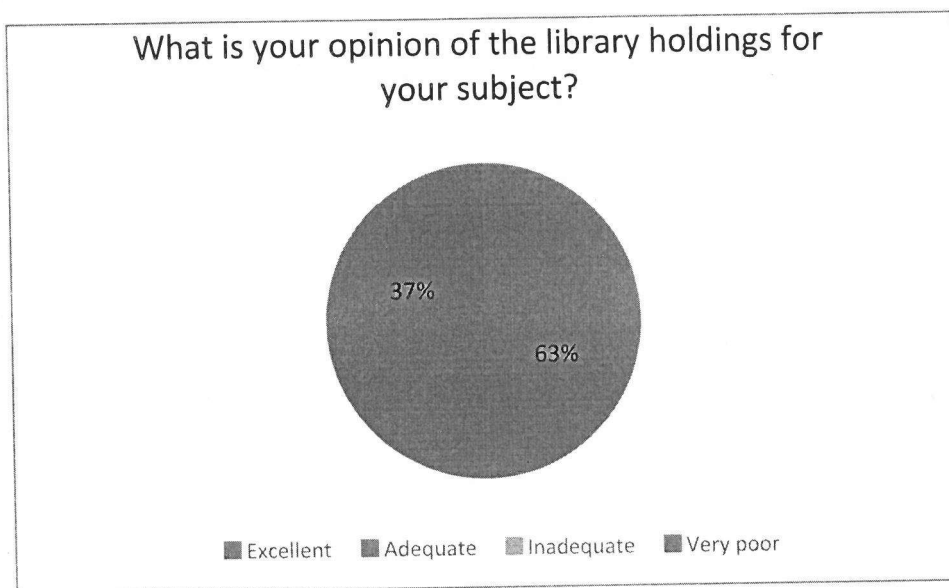

What is your opinion of the library holdings for your subject?



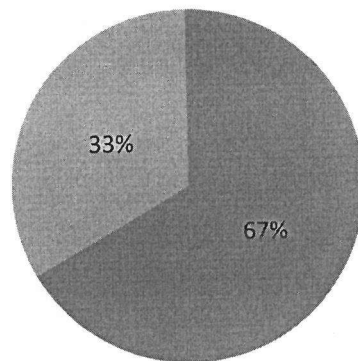

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Were you able to get the prescribed readings?



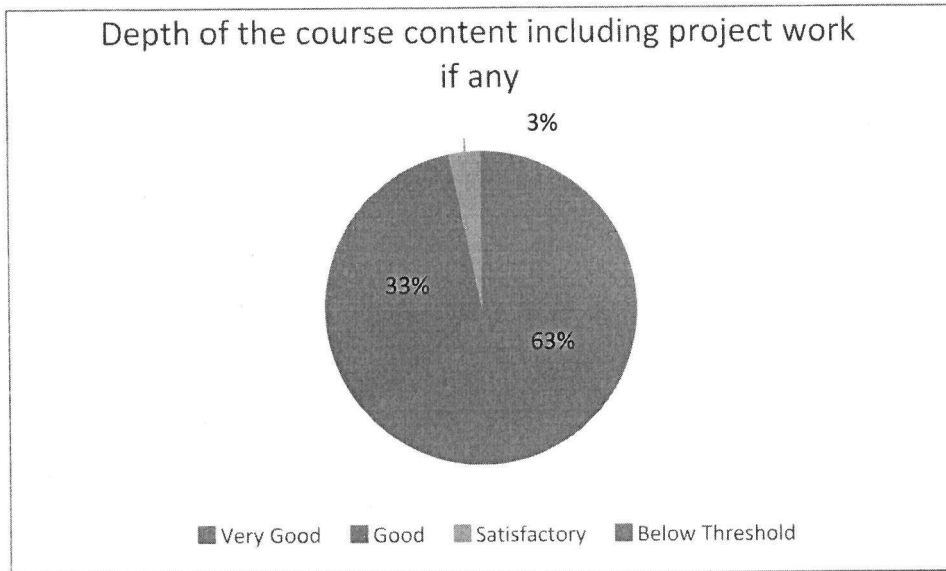

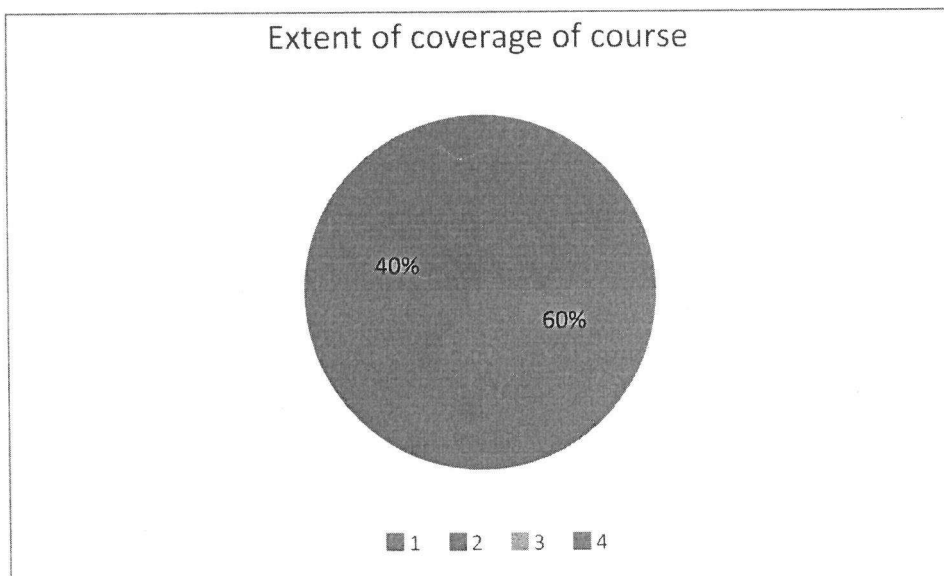
Q1	Depth of the course content including project work if any

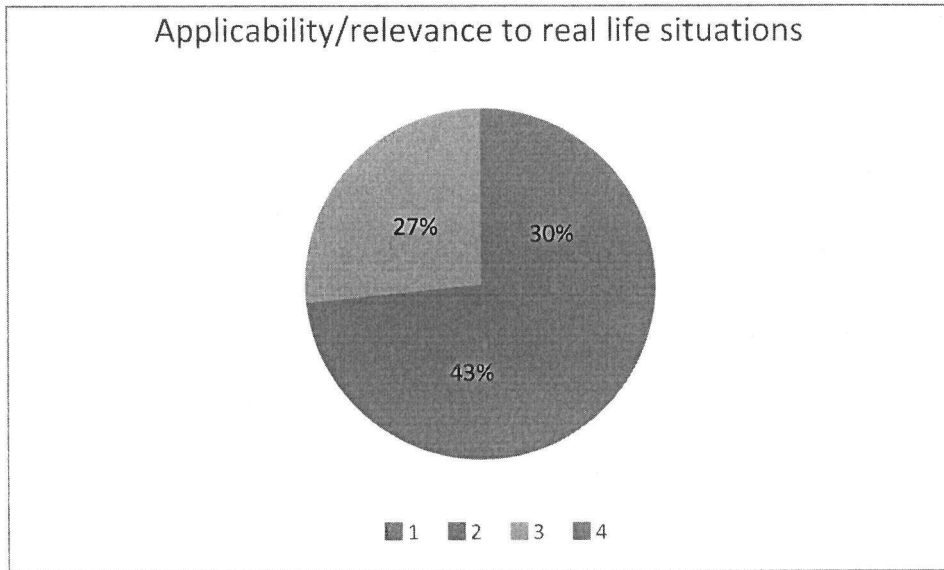
Q2	Extent of coverage of course

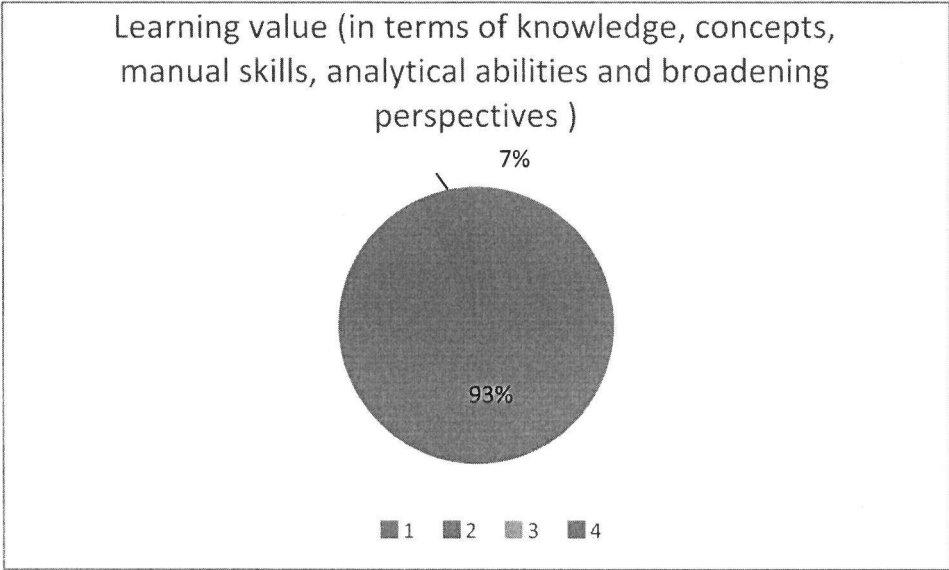
Q3	Applicability/relevance to real life situations

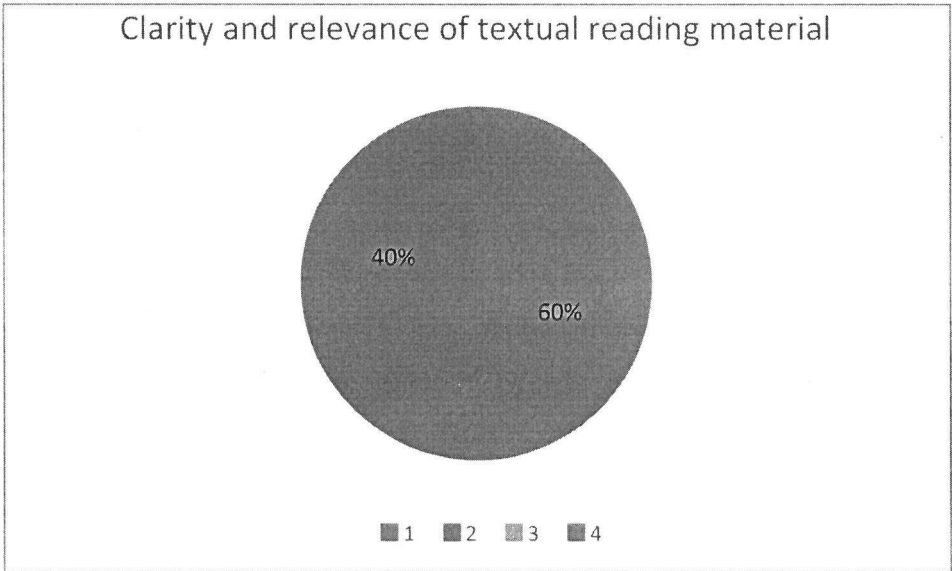
Q4	Learning value (in terms of knowledge, concepts, manual skills, analytical abilities and broadening perspectives)

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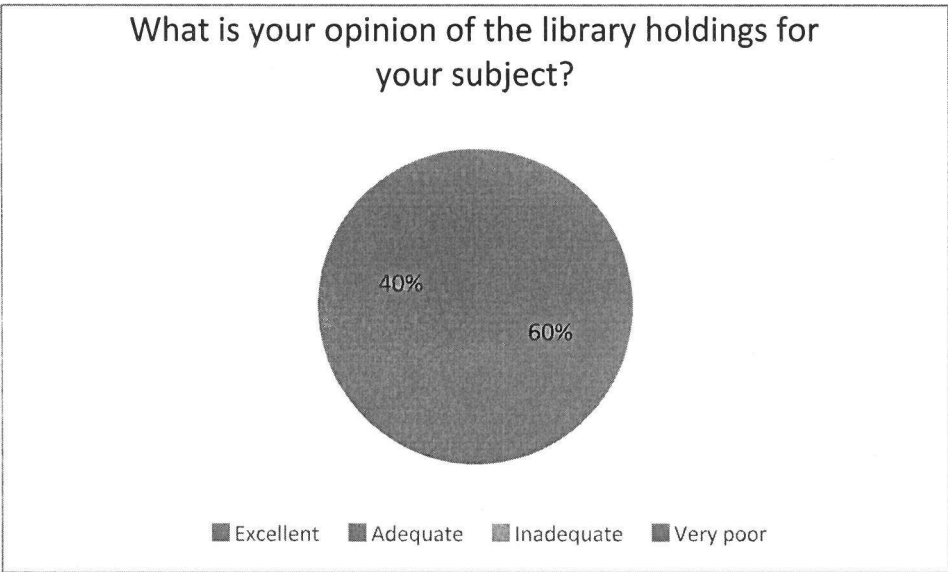

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All the students are of opinion that there was no practical/studio/workshop component of the courses sequenced integrally with the theory classes.

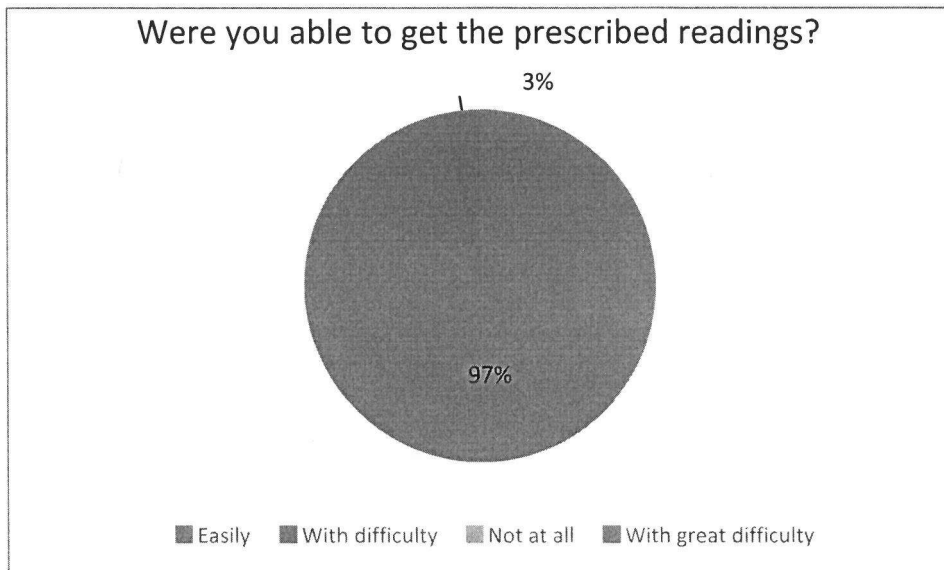
