Action Taken Report on Feedback of the Students – 2016 -17

It is observed from the feedback given by the students that the depth of the courses content is very good. They have given over all very good and good ratings to all the courses offered by the Department at Master level. The students found that the applicability of the course with the real life situations is very good. They could relate the course with the real life.

The students have access of the books from the central library and they can get books as per their needs. The overall picture coming out from the feedback given by the students with respect to the administrative facilities and functioning is found satisfactory. Most of the students replied that they are satisfied with the prospectus and information provided during the admission process. They are also found satisfy with the infrastructural facilities and administrative affairs. All the students have also given good feedback regarding library facilities, books and reading materials. Students have shown a very high confidence in the teaching faculties and their teaching ability. They have also shown their satisfaction with the continuous evaluation as well as examination system. In this context there is no need for any action to be taken.

Action Taken Report on Feedback of the Students - 2017 -18

Keeping in mind, the need of the students department has changed the syllabus in which elective and core courses have been incorporated. The same have been reflected in the prospectus and the Students found the information given in the prospectus appropriate and adequate. They were also satisfied with the core courses and elective courses offered.

Students found the administrative facilities and functioning reasonable. There is no departmental library. The Bhaikaka library has more books and journals for reference and reading. The central library staff provides orientation for the use of library facilities. Students are in general happy with teaching and learning support provided by the Department. They are also satisfied with evaluation and examination system. In short, viewing the feedback of the students, there was no need felt for any action to be taken.
