The academic activity feedback of student is normally an exercise that we conduct at end of semester on completion of final examination. Student are asked to fill up a standard response sheet containing questionnaires covering academic aspects. Student's identity is not to be mentioned in these feedback forms so that free and fair responses are obtained. The statistical analysis shows the following responses.

- Students found that the syllabus is sufficient and mostly benefiting them
- Large number of student responded that more than 70% syllabus was covered in the class room with good support of prescribed reading material through library
- More than 81% student have responded that participation of student is encouraged by teachers though question answer and discussion.
- The following observations are being made from the student's responses on individual project work along with individual faculty members.

93% students are satisfied and happy with the fairness of evaluation.

82% student found that the lab courses sequenced integrally with theory classes.

Approximately 89% student found that the academic interaction with teachers as and when required is satisfactory and good.

87% student found that the computer facility provided to them is adequate and centres.

71% student reported that library is must at department.

76% students are happy with their life at the university campus.

77% students reported that MCQ/Competition exam based training is necessary.

Action Taken:

1. Project works assigned to student that addresses some of these issues.
2. Teachers are asked to give more attention towards weaker student.
3. Student is encouraged to participate in national / state level eligibility tests.
4. Students training and awareness about competition examinations.
5. Students provide small library at the department of sociology.
6. Students trained MCQ based test.
