Terms of the Members

The tenure of the members in respect of 'B' and 'C' as above shall be two years.

Quorum for Members

The quorum for the meetings shall be 2 out of 3 members (including Chairman).

Terms of References:

- (1) The DAIP shall follow the principles of natural justice while deciding about the allegation of plagiarism against the student, faculty, researcher and staff of the University.
- (2) The DAIP shall have the power to assess level of plagiarism and recommend penalty (ies) accordingly.
- (3) The DAIP can co-opt a faculty member from the Department who is familiar with the subject area for which the plagiarism report is under consideration.
- (4) The DAIP after investigation shall submit its report with the recommendation on penalties to be imposed to the UAIP within a period of 45 days from the date of receipt of complain initiation of the proceedings.
- (5) If any member of the academic community suspects with appropriate proof that a case of Plagiarism has happened in any document pertaining to a Department, he or she shall report it to the concerned Departmental Academic Integrity Panel (DAIP). Upon receipt of such a complaint or allegation, the DAIP shall investigate the matter and submit its recommendations to the UAIP.

The tenure of this committee shall be in force from January-2021.
